I am sad to say that my December visit to St Andrews will be my last. I have been thinking about this for some time but believe that now is the right time. I am not getting any younger and I'm not able to expend the same physical effort that I used to.

As you may know, we have set up a permanent Fairtrade stall at St Mary's. This will be open every Monday morning with the Refresh café and Lynne Sparkes will run it after the service on Sundays.

I have calculated that that we have sold around £25,000 worth of Fairtrade goods between St Andrews and my other customers over the six years I have been doing this. Many producers, their families and their communities have benefitted from this generosity.

I would like to thank you all for your welcome, generosity and your interest in Fairtrade. I hope you will all be able to continue to use Fairtrade products.

I will miss the chats with my "regulars" but hope to visit you from time to time to see how everyone is.
