NEW SERVICE PATTERNS

Thank you to everyone who has contributed over the last few months to our consultation on service patterns. From September we will be trialling for 6 months two changes.

Firstly, we will be continuing to have traditional (8:45am) services in both churches but will be having Holy Communion on alternate weeks (1st and 3rd Sundays at St Andrew's, 2nd and 4th Sundays at All Saints) and a 'morning worship' service on the other Sundays.

From October, up at All Saints, we will also be trialling a monthly 4pm service '@4' for all ages, but particularly seeking to reach out to families. This will be on the 3rd Sunday of each month and instead of the 8:45 and 10:30 service on that day we will have a joint 9:30am traditional service up at All Saints. The 10:30am service at St Andrew's will continue as it is currently.

More details to follow and please be praying for these new patterns in this time of transition.
