PRAYING 'THY KINGDOM COME'

From Ascension Day to Pentecost (10-20 May) we shall be joining in a global ecumenical wave of prayer launched by the Archbishops of Canterbury and York. 'Thy Kingdom Come' is a simple invitation to pray for friends and family to come to faith. Now in its third year, participation has grown every year. By 2017 more than half a million had pledged to pray from more than 85 countries!

The changes to Data Protection legislation is a topic you can hardly miss at the moment - and the Church is included too. In the next couple of weeks the wardens of both churches will be asking everyone to complete a new consent form and to update information held about you and your family. Please help us by doing this quickly.

The Diocese is also re-running the Fairer Share process which they use to calculate equitably the Parish Share financial contribution. This involves an anonymous survey of individual incomes. Again may we ask you to complete your paperwork swiftly.

The wardens will be explaining both processes briefly in church, but do ask for clarification if you need further explanation.
